
Dear Justice Weaver,

Your letters have been forwarded to me. The May 2011 letter from this office incorrectly indicated that Associate Counsel Kim Uhuru was assigned to this matter. I am assigned to this matter, and any and all future correspondence should be directed as such.

You inquire why Director Corrigan is the only listed complainant. After Director Corrigan departed the Court, she asked to be treated as a complainant.

If you believe the JTC disposition jurisdictionally preempts AGC consideration of this matter, then please directly assert so. Should you assert that position, please provide a copy of the JTC disposition letter and be sure your assertion accounts for MCR 9.201(B)(3).

Finally, as you are aware, a Request for Investigation is not a determination of misconduct. This office is tasked with the duty and obligation to proceed with due diligence in investigative matters so that the Commission may properly determine how to conclude. That is what is taking place at this time.
